

Nō runga 'i te – Cook Islands Maori

Tē aruaru nei 'a Rātā nō tēta'i taiate tūranga 'āiteite 'ē te 'irinaki'ia.

'I te au mata'iti 'i 'aere'ia mai, kua kite mātou ē, ko tā mātou tu'anga moni tauturu, 'e rauka ana 'i tē reira te tau'i 'i te au ārairai'anga ki te au mea 'ē manako-kore 'ua 'ia ana e tēta'i au ma'ata'anga tangata, 'i roto 'i te au matakeinanga.

Ko tā mātou e 'ākara-tāmou nei, koia 'okī, ko te turuturu 'i te au putuputu'anga matakeinanga 'ē 'anga'anga nei, nō te 'akaiti, mē kore ra, kōpae atu 'i te au ārairai'anga, 'ē te 'ōronga'anga 'i te tauturu kia rātou tei anoano.

Nā roto 'i tā mātou au porōkarāmu tauturu, tē 'akakoro nei mātou 'i te turuturu 'i te au putuputu'anga rikiriki 'ē te mama'ata, nā roto 'i te au tū peu, tū piri'anga, tū ao nātura, mē kore ra, au 'akakoro'anga matakeinanga 'i roto ia Nelson, Marlborough, Canterbury 'ē te au 'enua 'ō te Chatham.

- **Tāmou** – tūranga 'āiteite nō te tāmou'anga 'i roto 'i te ora'anga
- **Turuturu** – Turuturu'anga 'i te tangata kia pu'apinga atu
- **'Ātui** – 'ātui'anga ki te tangata, te ngā'i, 'ē te peu
- **Piri'anga ki roto** - 'akaātea'anga 'i te au ārairai'anga nō te piri'anga ki roto
- **'Ākono** - 'ākono'anga 'i te ao nātura

- au moni tūtaki 'i te 'akakoro'anga, mē kore, au moni nō te tā'anga'anga 'i te 'akakoro'anga (Au Moni Tauturu Rikiriki 'ē te Mama'ata)
- au 'akakoro'anga 'anga'ia tē ka 'ōronga mai 'i te vā ki te au ngā'i 'ē te au tu'anga tauturu 'i roto 'i te au ngā'i ka anoano'ia
- te 'akamātūtū, 'ē te 'akamāro'iro' 'i te 'āpi' 'ua atu rāi 'i kite 'ē te pakari o roto

- Au putuputu'anga, kāre e nō te kimi meitaki nō rātou 'ua'orāi
- Au putuputu'anga piri'anga pātana 'anga'anga kāpiti

Tu'anga tauturu 'i te pati'anga

- 'Ātoro 'i tā mātou kupe-roro-uira.
- Kia tano te au pati'anga ki tēta'i 'o tā mātou au 'akakoro'anga pu'apinga rava atu 'ē rima.
- 'Akatanō 'i tā'au pati'anga kia kitea meitaki 'ua 'ia 'ē te poto.
- Tāniuniu mai ia mātou, nō te tuatua nō runga 'i tō'ou tika'anga, mē kore, te tūranga 'ō te 'akano'ono'o'anga 'ō te pati'anga.
- 'E 'akateretere'anga rōra tā mātou nō runga 'i te 'akateretere'anga 'ō te pati'anga. Parāni nō te 10 'epetoma nō te pati'anga moni tauturu meangiti (raro ake 'i te \$20,000) 'ē, 'e 4 marama nō te moni tauturu mama'ata ('i runga ake 'i te \$20,000).

- Keep your applications clear and concise.
- Give us a call to talk about eligibility or the application process.
- We have a rolling application process. Plan for a 10-week turnaround for small grants (below \$20,000) and 4 months for large grants (above \$20,000).

What we don't fund

- Individuals
- Retrospective applications
- Projects where the benefit is outside our funding regions
- Competitive or elite sports
- Research
- Projects with no community involvement
- Scholarships
- Commercial organisations
