Find a staff or community member to offer cultural support for Muslim whānau and tamariki?

Identify and use resources to make Muslim culture visible in our environment?

Actively address bullying and racism to ensure Muslim whānau can stand tall in their culture, language, and identity?

Provide a respectful place where Muslim tamariki can undertake their cultural practices?

Create a safe online space where kaiako and Muslim whānau can interact and be informed?

Display these important teaching dispositions in our transition practices: respectfulness, courage, curiosity, critical reflection, warmth, openness, and love?
