Mō mātau

He porihanga tautika, he porihanga toitū tā Rātā e whai ai.

Kua kitea e mātau i roto i ngā tau, ka nui ake te hua o tā mātau pūtea i roto i ngā hapori he nui ake ngā taero ki te whiwhi i ngā āhuatanga ka riro noa i ētahi atu.

- **Te Tūhono** – kia whai hononga ki te tangata, ki te takiwā, ki te ahurea
- **Te Whai Wāhi Mai** – te turaki taero hai whakawātea i te ara
- **Te Ukauka** – kia kaha ake anō te toitūtanga taiao

- All applications must align to one of our five priorities.
- Keep your applications clear and concise.
- Give us a call to talk about eligibility or the application process.
- We have a rolling application process. Plan for a 10-week turnaround for small grants (below \$20,000) and 4 months for large grants (above \$20,000).

What we don't fund

- Individuals
- Retrospective applications
- Projects where the benefit is outside our funding regions
- Competitive or elite sports
- Research
- Projects with no community involvement
- Scholarships
- Commercial organisations
